LARKIN HEALTH PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION AWARD

Presented annually to recognize one or more individuals (health practitioner, education coordinator, learner, or community member) for their outstanding commitment and dedication to community based health professional education and/or the promotion of the health professions within Ontario's rural and smaller urban communities as a career.

Eligible expenses will include individual awards of at least \$1,000 plus the expenses relating to the awards promotion, the selection of its recipient(s) and the travel and accommodation expenses of the latter to receive the award. There will be at least one award per annum. Selection of the recipient(s) will be based upon nominations invited from the learners, community coordinators, hospital administrators and preceptors of ROMP and will be adjudicated by the Regional Directors of ROMP, one of whom must hold an academic appointment at McMaster University, or by their successors.

The award is based on activities up to and including the current academic year.

The nomination must include contact information for the nominee and a one-page statement as to the qualities and contributions of the nominee to warrant this nomination.
