- Postgraduate Specialty Preceptor of the year
- Undergraduate Family Medicine Preceptor of the year
- Undergraduate Specialty Preceptor of the year
- New Preceptor of the year

### **Preceptor of the Year Awards – Criteria:**

Mandatory requirements:

- 1) A registered teaching physician with ROMP for a minimum of 2 years\*
- 2) Taught 3-5 ROMP undergraduate learners or 2 postgraduate learners per year
- 3) Taught at least one unfunded learner per year
- 4) Exceptional learner evaluations
- 5) Established interaction with the ROMP office

\*New Preceptor: new to ROMP within the last 2 years
